Philanthropic Activities

Annually we award approximately 12 merit scholarships to children or grandchildren of members.

We also make charitable contributions annually. Past contributions helped the Air Force Assistance Fund, Air Force Aid Society, American Liver Transplant Fund, a Korean orphanage (supported by an AFOSI unit). Local chapters participate in charitable activities determined by their size and members' interests.

Fraternal Activities

Chapters meet on various schedules. We hold national conventions biennially in different locations voted by the membership. Past conventions have been at Oklahoma City; Washington, DC; Sacramento; Clearwater, FL; Denver; San Antonio; Philadelphia; Albuquerque; a Caribbean Cruise, and Las Vegas.

The Association is a non-profit fraternal and charitable organization of about 2,000 members founded in 1966.

All former and current members of the Air Force Office of Special Investigations, dating from its inception on 1 August 1948, are eligible for membership.

Persons who were Special Agents enroll as Regular Members. Non-investigative persons, both military and civilian, may enroll in Regular or Associate status. Spouses of deceased members may enroll as Associate Members.

Philanthropy

The Association is a tax-exempt non-profit organization under Internal Revenue Code Section 501c(3). We generate scholarship and charitable monies through tax deductible contributions by members to a Scholarship/Memorial Fund.

Fraternal
